Consolidate a variety of positions contained in the Charter under the title of Assistant City I Manager of Administrative Services. Change the process for adopting the city's budget so that it is adopted by July of each year. Have the library participate in the same payment procedures as all other city departments. Allow for the conditions and procedures for public works contracts to be established by ordinance. Make the Charter's language gender neutral and standardize language throughout the charter.
