IV. Status of Requested Elections Facility ADA Upgrades (5 minutes) – Michael Lui

- 1. DPW confirmed that the unused funds from our previous ADA capital improvement plan (ramp from Tower to front door) were reclaimed by CMO (we were originally allocated \$3.6 million but \$3 million was reclaimed.
- 2. DPW has a list of Board approved projects for this fiscal year, but our new ADA plan is not on this list despite our available \$350k in our budget for some of our ADA upgrades this year.
- 3. DPW mentioned they might be able to bring a consultant to start planning, but it sounds like an exception to their normal processes.
- 4. DPW said we can meet again the week of 1/17 and they will let us know if they are able to engage an ADA consultant in the near term to start evaluating ADA improvements.

- 5. If our ADA plan was approved, it is not feasible to complete the projects this year lucky to get completion by June 2022 unknown consequences to the election.

An ADA consultant to the County provided a report on every building barrier and how to address it. Elections had a different consultant.

Consensus to have the Chair of the Commission on Disabilities meet with the VAAC Chair and Co-chair, with staff support, to discuss Elections DPW proposal. Michael Lui will send the proposal to the VAAC for review.

The Commission has a meeting on February 4, and Andrew would like to share the Elections DPW proposal at that time.
