Measure DD is brought to you by preschool experts, teachers, childcare providers, parents, and the people of South San Francisco.

Measure DD:

- 1. Benefits all South San Francisco residents and the local economy. Almost 3,000 children will be served, saving families thousands of dollars a month. 400 low-income teachers and workers will receive a true living wage. The South San Francisco "Childcare Master Plan" says: for every \$1 invested in preschool, we receive \$8.60 in societal benefits.
- 2. Provides preschool for all who need it. Childcare fiscal experts agree there is sufficient funding.
- 3. Ensures programs are accountable and SAFE. Programs must follow California's Health and Safety Code. A citizen oversight body and City Council will ensure high-quality standards are met. Measure DD is subject to quarterly financial reports, public hearings, and independent evaluations:
