81	February 13, 2015	10-calendar-day public review period begins February 13, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. and ends February 23, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. for primary arguments filed in favor of and against measures. Between these dates the Elections Official or any registered voter, eligible to vote on the contest in question, may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted if found to be misleading or inaccurate. 71	February 23, 2015	Rebuttal Arguments for measures where a primary argument was filed both in favor and against are due by 5:00 p.m. Such arguments may be changed until and including today. EC §§9501-04
71	February 23, 2015	10-calendar-day public review period begins February 23, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. and ends March 5, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. for rebuttal arguments filed in favor and/or against measures and impartial analyses. Between these dates the Elections Official or any registered voter, eligible to vote on the contest in question, may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted if found to be misleading or inaccurate. 60	March 6, 2015	Military and Overseas Voters' ballot application period begins. EC §§300(b), 3105
45	March 21, 2015	County Elections Official must send ballots and balloting material to all Military and Overseas Voters who filed ballot applications by March 21, 2015. EC §3114
29	April 6, 2015	Between these dates, Vote by Mail ballots & Voter Information Pamphlet will be sent to all registered voters. To ensure that the voter has enough time to return their ballot, the last day to request a replacement Vote by Mail ballot through the mail is April 28, 2015. Requests made after April 28, 2015 must be made in person at a Voting Center. EC §§3001, 3023, 13303

15	April 20, 2015	Voter registration closes on this date for the May 5, 2015 Special All Mail Ballot Election. Voters must register by this date to be eligible to vote in this election. Voter registration forms postmarked prior to or with this date are accepted. EC §§2102, 2107
7	April 28, 2015	Last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot through the mail. Requests made after April 28, 2015 must be made in person at a Voting Center. EC §§3001, 3023, 13303
0	May 5, 2015	Election Day. EC §1500
3	May 8, 2015	Vote by Mail ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received by the County Elections Official by this date shall be counted. EC §§3020, 3117, 4103
30	June 4, 2015	Last day for County Elections Official to certify election results to the jurisdictions participating in the election. EC §15372
