## Argument in Favor of Measure\_

(City of East Palo Alto: Revisions to "Rent Stabilization and Just Cause for Eviction Ordinance" (Rent Stabilization Measure)

Let's keep our community affordable for seniors, working families, our children and our future. Help prevent displacement. VOTE YES on \_

Since 1984 East Palo Alto has had a strong voter approved rent stabilization law that protects / residents against unjust rent increases and evictions by those who cared more about speculation and profit and less about the community.

A YES vote on Measure\_will strengthen and streamline the updated Rent Stabilization and Just Cause for Eviction Ordinance/(RSO) passed in 2010.

Measure \_ continues the tradition of protection and fairness in rental housing for our community. A lt simplifies administrative procedures for landlords and tenants. It reinforces protection for tenants from displacement and exorbitant rent increases, and guarantees property owners the right to a fair return on their investments.

The City Council has unanimously placed this Measure on the ballot after extensive public input from tenants, homeowners, and landlords.

A YES vote on Measure \_ will: ->

\*STRENGTHEN compliance with eviction-related notice requirements to tenants.

\*CLARIFY the calculations for how much rent can increase each year.

\*CLARIFY the definition of maximum allowable rent.

\*CREATE more efficiency and cost savings by modifying the annual registration requirements.

\*REVISE the registration fee pass-through.

\*AUTHORIZE City Council to revise any part of the ordinance when in conflict with federal or state law.

\*PRESERVE landlords' right to a fair return.
